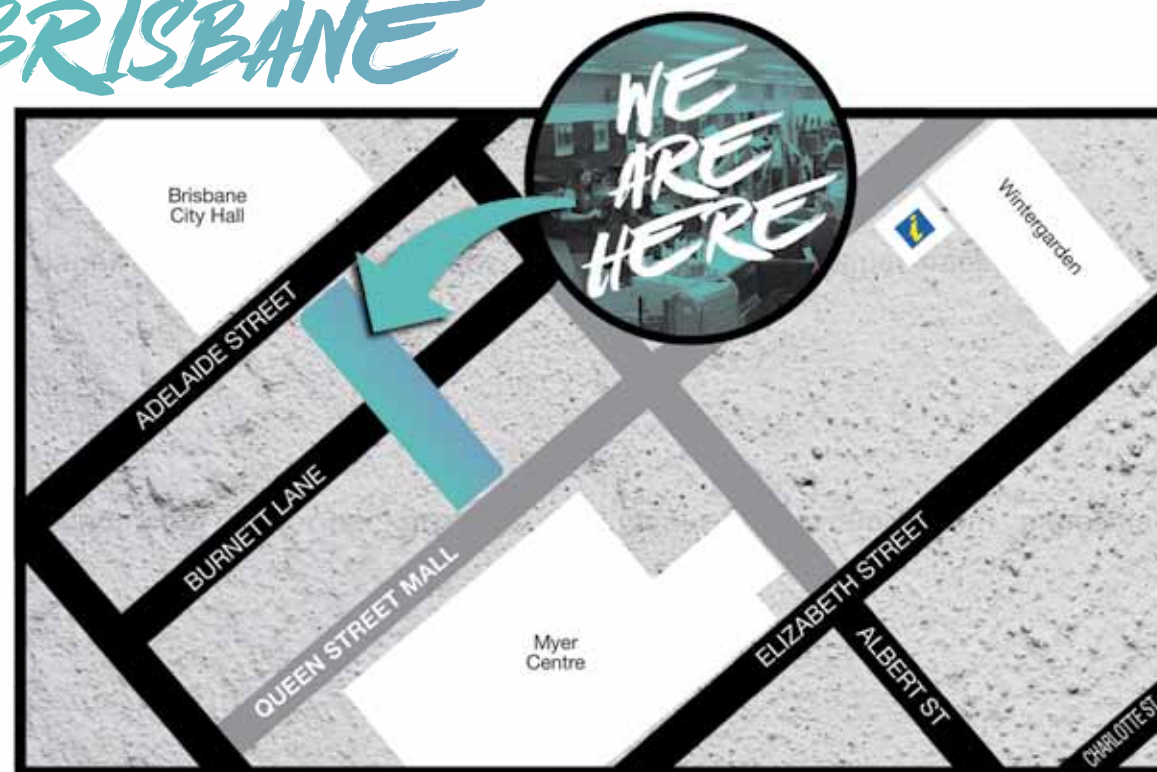

BEAUTY COURSES
